

Vacancy: Assistant Researcher, Human Rights Division (20 hours)

GHRD is looking for an Assistant Researcher at its Human Rights division. The Assistant researcher helps monitor the human rights situation in South Asia and assists in drafting relevant human rights reports to highlight to relevant human rights issues.

Please note that this is a part time position for 20 hours per week.

Salary: 800 euros (net) per month.

Job description

- Conduct news scans (scanning of newspaper articles, magazines) on daily basis to monitor human rights situation in South Asia.
- In depth research and analysis of human rights situation in South Asia. Drafting of human rights reports, and other articles for the website.
- Process human rights cases submitted by GHRD's local partners.
- Assist in organizing events and activities carried out by GHRD as required.
- Perform any other task related to the aforementioned activities.

Job requirements

- Excellent communication skills. Applicants must be fluent (written and oral) in English.
- Advanced university degree (Masters level) in International Law/ Human Rights Law or related fields. Applicants must ensure that they have advanced knowledge of human rights law. Knowledge of international relations or developmental studies would not suffice for this position.
- Knowledge/ experience of human rights issues in South Asia is essential.
- Applicants are required to have the necessary work permit in the Netherlands for this position.

Applicants must be able to work independently and with minimum supervision, capable of handling high stress situations and capable of adapting to a changing organizational structure.

Application procedure

Interested applicants may submit their i. CV, ii. letter of motivation (detailing how their education and previous work experience would enable them to qualify for this position), and iii. Names of 2 reference along with email and phone numbers (reference letters are not required). Please mention "Vacancy: Assistant Researcher" as the subject.
